



District of Columbia Information Sheet for Yellow Fever Stamp Owners

Applicant must:

- Be a licensed physician, pharmacist, or nurse practitioner in good standing with the District of Columbia
- Log in to the DC Health, <u>Health Professional Licensing Portal</u> and select "Apply for Yellow Fever License".
- Complete the <u>District of Columbia Uniform Stamp application</u> and email it to Dr. Tameshaa'
 Ventiere at tameshaa.ventiere@dc.gov.
- Complete the initial and annual on site inspection of the facility where the yellow fever vaccine
 will be administered. The Pharmaceutical Control Division will contact you to schedule the
 inspection.
- Upon successful completion of an on site inspection, complete the <u>Authorization for Ordering</u>
 form and submit to Sanofi after receiving the YF permit.
- Read and understand the <u>recommendations</u> outlined by the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).
- Provide a copy of the <u>Vaccine Information Statement (VIS)</u> to every Yellow Fever vaccine recipient prior to administering the vaccine.
- Adhere to the administration, storage, and handling requirements as indicated by ACIP and the Yellow Fever vaccine manufacturer.
- Record Yellow Fever vaccine with official uniform stamp on the ICVP (International Certificate of Vaccine Prophylaxis) card. DC Health does not issue YF stamps. You can order the ICVP card by calling: 202-512-1800 or online at http://bookstore.gpo.gov/catalog/health-benefits/immunizationvaccination/vaccination-forms
- Provide continuous temperature monitoring for vaccination and maintain a temperature log of daily recording (This will need to be provided during annual facility inspection).
- Re-certify as yellow fever stamp owner when professional license expires.
- Yellow Fever Stamp Owner Permit is not transferable. You must notify us if there is a change of Permit Holder 15 days prior to the change. A new application for the new YF Permit Stamp Owner will be required.
- Yellow Fever Stamp Owner is approved for one practitioner for each approved Yellow Fever Facility.

Practitioners may administer Yellow Fever vaccine may administer the vaccine under the YF
 Stamp Owner Permit.
